About the Indianola Solar Project

- **Location:** The solar field sits on 25 acres of IMU-owned land next to the city's water department at 1602 S. K Street.
- **Power Size:** The system can produce 4.1 megawatts (MW) of electricity at peak output.
- **Annual Energy:** It will generate up to 6.5 million kilowatt-hours (kWh) of electricity every year — enough to power hundreds of homes.
- **Lower Costs:** This means IMU buys less power when prices are highest, helping keep electric rates more stable over time.
- **Grid Savings:** By producing local solar power, IMU can reduce its reliance on outside electricity:
 - Up to 10% less** grid power needed during summer peaks.
 - Up to 40% less** during winter.
